This Indenture made the 11th day of April 1818 Between Richard P Fletcher one of the Overseers of the Poor for the West District of the Country of Rochinghans, of the one part and Adam Fisher of the County and Itale agores aid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Overseer of the Poor in pursuance of an order of the Court of said County bearing date at March Court 1811 doth put and lind Michael Ingder orphan of Lacob Ingder Deceased (who will be 21 years of age on the 14th day of Getober Next) as an apprentice to him the said Adam Fisher with him the said Adam Fisher after the manner of an apprentice to dwell and Ferve until he I hall arrive at the age of twenty one years, to learn the art Trade and Mystery of a Statter in all its Narious Branches during which time the said Michael Luyder Shall serve the said Idam Fisher in all his Lawful Commands and honertly and obediently in all things Shall behave himself towards his said Marter and the said Adams Fisher for his part doth hereby Covenant and promise to and with the said Overseen Richard P Fletcher or to his successor in Office to teach or cause to be taught or instructed the said Michael Inyder Reading Writing and I rethralie through the single rule of three and the art Mystery and Trade as afores aid during said ferm and more over to find the said Michael Inyder in good Lufficient Clothing Meat Dainh Washing and lodging, fit and Convenient for Said apprentice and also at the end of Said time to pay to the Said Michael Inyder for freedoms Lues fifteen Gollars In Mitness whereof the Said Overseen of the Foor and I dam Fisher hath hereunto set their hands and Leals on the day and years above written Richard & Hetelur Giail Ligned Lealed & Delivered ) In presence of wellh Adam Tisher Liang Michael Nowman
