

This Indenture MADE THE 16th day of June

in the year of our Lord 1845 Between Peter Henton

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the _____ District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and

Abner Harrison of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date the December Court in the year 1844 has

placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind ~~Stenratta Plumb~~ of the age of ~~10~~ years the day of Nov^r 1844, ~~years~~ to be an Apprentice with him the said Abner Harrison and as an Apprentice with him the said Abner Harrison to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said

~~Stenratta Plumb~~ shall arrive, and come to the age of ~~10~~ years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said

~~St. Plumb~~ shall the said Abner Harrison well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said ~~Stenratta Plumb~~ shall be put unto

by his said ~~St. Harrison~~ according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said ~~Stenratta Plumb~~ and the said ~~Stenratta Plumb~~ honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said Abner

~~Harrison~~ and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said Abner Harrison

And the said ~~Stenratta Plumb~~ ~~for himself~~ his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said

Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of ~~Shoes Making~~ which he the said now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform,

or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said

Abner Harrison shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

Abner Harrison shall teach, or cause to be taught to the Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said ~~Twenty~~ ~~fourty~~

dollars as per agreement ~~the sum of~~ ~~Dollars~~ at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
