

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE *Twentieth* day of *December*

in the year of our Lord 18*23* Between *Philip Koontz* Overseer of the Poor of the

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Daniel Matthews*

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid
bearing date the *3rd* day of *November* in the year *1823*

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *James Winder* of the age
of *12* years, to be an Apprentice with him the said *Daniel Matthews*

and as an Apprentice with him the said *Daniel Matthews* to dwell from the date of these presents,
until the said *James Winder* shall arrive and come to the age of *Twentyone*

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said
James Winder shall the said *Matthews* his said

Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *James Winder*
shall be put unto by *his said Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of

the said *James Winder* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards
Said Matthews his said Master and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

of the said *Matthews* And the said *Daniel Matthews*
for himself *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a *Farmer*
which he the said *Matthews* now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that
he the said *Daniel Matthews* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that
the said *Matthews* shall teach or cause to be taught to the said *James Winder*

Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said
James Winder the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the

aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year
above written.
