for himself Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his
Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Crast, Mystery and Occupation of a Thing terformer terfor
which he the said Olodes in his family: now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,
instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that
he the said George Modes shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient
meat, drink, appearel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that
the said Nodes shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Degget proper
Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said
Obeggey the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the
