This indenture made the 28th day of August one thousand eight hundred and fore between Alexander Graham overseer of the poor for the south district in the county of Rockingham of the one part and Martin Burkholder of said county of the other part witnesseth that the said overseer of the poor in pursuance of an order of cort of said county bearing date April coart last doe put place and bind Rudy Fry a poor boy age eight years old in February last as an apprentice unto the said Martin Burkholder to dwell with and serve him until he shall arrive to the age of 21 years

In consideration whereof the said Burkholder doth bind himself to the said Graham or his successor overseer of the poor to teach and instruct or cause to be taught the said apprentice the art and mistery of a wheel right within the time above mentioned and to find the said apprentice cloath meat drink and lodging fit and convenient for such an apprentice and to teach or cause him to be taught to read wright and common arthimatick including the rule of three and at the end of his servitude shall give unto the said apprentice such freedom dues as the law directs in witness wherof each of us haith hereunto sett our hands and seals the day and year above written
