

IMPORTANT SUGGESTIONS AND REMINDERS:

- I. All dates must be in Senior Hall, Alumnae Hall, or porches of Reed and Wilson Halls, and walks around quadrangle - never back of buildings or as far down as the street in front of the campus.
- II. The quadrangle ends on walk between Ashby and Spotswood. Use concrete sidewalks, not porches of dormitories.
- III. Girls, without dates, cannot lounge on campus or walk nearer the street than the end of the quadrangle - cannot sit on wall to sidewalk at Carter House - cannot talk to men on street.
- IV. The only place for sun bathing is around the out of doors swimming pool. Use bathing suits and wear dresses over them as you go and come from swimming pool. Cannot use fire escapes, porches, open windows, golf course, or around the dormitories. There is not one private or secluded spot on this campus!
- V. Cannot stay out on campus after 7:30 p. m. at anytime in spring.
- VI. Cannot talk with men or boys who pass through or by campus at anytime - nor talk from town with boys.
- VII. Cannot roll on grass or lounge carelessly anywhere on campus at anytime.
- VIII. Remember that from the highway people can see the front of campus, from the railroad tracks and nearby farms, people can see the south side and back of the campus, and the traps are always down at the trestle.
- IX. Mr. Earley is held responsible for conditions on campus.
- X. Council Members and Standards Committee Members will be on duty to give call-downs on Sundays and at all other times when they see irregularities.
- XI. You may wear socks to breakfast on Sunday morning but at no other time during that day. May wear socks with gold attire.
- XII. Cannot use Big Gym or tennis courts at anytime on Sunday - use swimming pool during dip hours only.
- XIII. Cannot wear split coats over bathing suits, nor let your coats fly open in front. *Gym Suits*
- XIV. At no time during your stay on campus will you be permitted to wear shorts, gym suits, or culottes on tennis courts, golf links, or baseball field.
- XV. Remember that in the spring of the year noise carries through open windows, open doors, and open transoms.
- XVI. Cannot go to or from swimming pool at anytime in pajamas - or in any kind of apparel that makes you conspicuous on the campus.
- XVII. Remember, also, that you are to return to campus before 6:00 p. m. unless you have the class privilege of being down town during dinner hour, or unless you have secured permission. If the picture show lasts until 6:00 p.m. or after, come home at once and sign an "Off Campus Card" for same. Do not go to soda shoppes before you come home. Secure permission to get something to eat if you missed dinner or wait until Tea Room opens.

- XVIII. When you go down town out of your class groupings you have to secure permission from my office beforehand.
- XIX. Wear hats to town, freshen up always before going to town. Remember that you represent your student group and your college while you are on the streets. Do not embarrass either!

NOTE: A man phoned my office recently to ask if students might go to ED'S PLACE when they were spending the weekend in some home out of Harrisonburg. The answer is "NO". The student involved should not have permitted him to seek such information for she knew she couldn't go.
